Company and Location:

- **Company** – Oceanfront hotel and restaurant
- **Community** – Atlantic resort town, year round population of about 7000, hosting 8 million + visitors annually!
- **Location** – Part of a barrier island on the East Coast of Maryland. About 150 miles (241 km) SE of Washington, D.C. and 240 miles (386 km) S of New York City.
- **Weather** – Hot during the day, warm during the evening. Average temperatures range between 75 and 100 degrees Fahrenheit (23-38 degrees Celsius)

Job Position:

- **Room Attendant** – Clean and sanitize guest rooms and bathrooms \$11.75/hr
 - **Grill Cook** – Prepare food in kitchen or grill. \$11.75/hr
 - **Food Runner** – Serve food from kitchen to tables. \$11.75/hr
 - **Busser** – Clean and reset tables, clean restaurant and bathrooms. \$11.75/hr
 - **Server** – Serve drinks and food. \$3.63/hr plus tips
 - **Hostess** – Greet guests, take to table, and answer questions. \$11.75/hr
 - **Expeditor** – Work with kitchen to get food ready for customers. \$11.75/hr
 - **Area Attendant** – Maintenance and cleaning of outside area. \$11.75/hr
 - **Dishwasher** – Wash dishes, clean kitchen, assist in kitchen. \$11.75/hr
 - **Runner** – General property maintenance and assist with housekeeping. \$11.75/hr
 - **Lifeguard** – Monitor pool and keep guests safe. \$12.00/hr
 - **Line Cook** – Prepare and cook food. Clean kitchen and dishes. \$11.75/hr
 - **Prep Cook** – Food prep and cleaning. \$11.75/hr
 - **Laundry Attendant** – Wash dirty laundry and towels, dry and fold. \$11.75/hr
- All positions require standing for the duration of your shift, general restaurant duties as assigned & cleaning safely with chemicals!*
- **Hours** – Average 32+ hours per week
 - **Start Date:** May 10 – May 15; May 20 – June 15
 - **End Date:** DS End Date



Employment Conditions:

- Advanced English skills for interacting with customers with a positive attitude.
- The first 3 weeks will be a training period where the hours may be reduced until you are immersed in your full time schedule.
- Hours and schedule will vary each week, must be available and able to work holidays, weekdays, and weekends (Saturday, Sunday) as scheduled.
- **Uniform** – Uniforms will be discussed upon arrival.
- **Social Security Number** - Approximately seven days after you check into the program you will apply for a social security card. You will be able to work before you receive your card but you must provide a receipt to prove you have applied.

Housing and Transportation: (all photos below are example only for reference)

- **Overview of housing situation:** Assigned upon arrival in sponsor approved housing in West OC or OC. Located in motel/trailer/cottage/apartment style housing. Expect one bed per person (bunk bed style), micro/fridge, full bathroom.
- **Housing Fees:** Expect a seasonal rental fee between \$1900 and \$2100.
- **Additional Housing Fees:** Housing deposit of \$250 to be paid 4 weeks in advance with your first rental payment of \$250. \$200 of your deposit is eligible for refund upon successful program completion, damage inspection, and positive rental obligation standing. \$50 is a non-refundable admin fee.
 - **A total of 4 equal seasonal rent payments will be due in the USA prior to your 10th week on program. Payment schedule: 4 payments to be made: 1 in week 3, 1 in week 5, 1 in week 7, and 1 in week 9.**
- **Transportation** – You will walk/bike/ride share to and from work each day. Public transportation in Ocean City can be utilized for \$3.00 per day. All transportation is your financial responsibility.
- **Bike Safety Reminder** – Always wear a helmet & reflective gear, utilize a blinking light, and obey all traffic signs and lights!
